The goal of the school nurse is to build and maintain a healthy school community by implementing strategies promoting student and staff health and safety, assuring students will remain in the classroom.

The school nurse provides education to students and staff on topics such as proper hand washing, good hygiene, and nutrition. The provision of this education to students and staff helps nurses minimize the spread of contagious diseases and maximize the potential for learning. The school nurses also provide follow-up care to reduce the number of absences, increasing the amount of instructional time for students.
